April 25: Before We Were Yours by Lisa Wingate

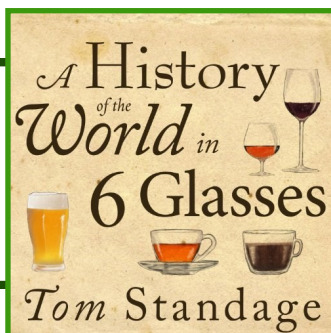
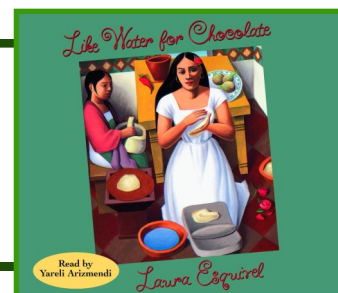
Historical Domestic Fiction

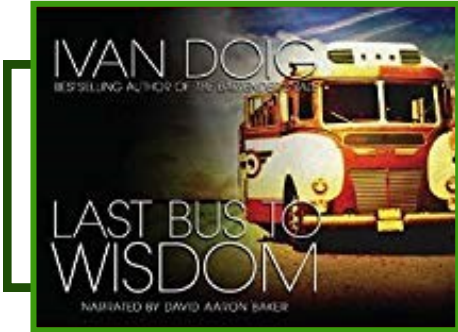
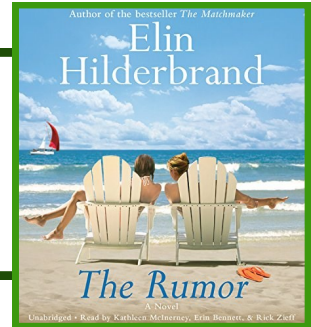

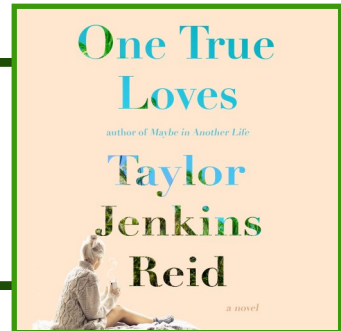
