Call to Order

Approval of Minutes

Mayor Sewell asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the regular council meeting that was held on May 20, 2013.

A motion was made by Council Member Crawford seconded by Council Member Shepherd to approve the minutes of the regular council meeting held on May 20, 2013. Motion carried.

Fiscal Year 2014 Budget

City Manager, Perry Hicks briefly summarized the budget figures for each fund and stated that these were advertised in the Gateway Beacon on May 23, 2013 and also on

May 30, 2013. A public hearing was held on May 30, 2013 for the new budget. Hicks stated that there are copies of the new budget available to anyone who wishes to have a copy. Those can be picked up at city hall during regular business hours.

Mayor Sewell asked for a motion to approve the FY-2014 Budget as presented.

A motion was made by Council Member Crawford seconded by Council Member Parrish to approve the budget for FY-2014 as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Office of the Prosecuting Attorney of the Municipal Court Ordinance

City Attorney, Sam Price stated that by accepting this ordinance, we are establishing the office of the prosecuting attorney of the City of Bremen Municipal Court. He stated that there will be a resolution separate from the ordinance for the purpose of appointing an individual to the position of prosecuting attorney.

A motion was made by Council Member Parrish seconded by Council Member Wilson to accept the ordinance to establish the office of the prosecuting attorney of the City of Bremen Municipal Court. The motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Sewell asked for a motion to accept the resolution appointing Robert J. Harker to prosecuting attorney of the City of Bremen Municipal Court.

Motion by Council Member Crawford seconded by Council Member Parrish to appoint Robert J. Harker as prosecuting attorney of the City of Bremen Municipal Court. The motion carried unanimously.

Zoning Map Approval

Mayor Sewell stated that the approval of the zoning map is needed due to color corrections being made to the previously approved zoning map.

The zoning map was on display for everyone to view if they so desired to do so.

Mayor Sewell asked for a motion to approve the zoning map.

A motion was made by Council Member Wilson seconded by Council Member Shepherd to approve the zoning map. Motion carried.
