THE PURPOSE OF THIS SPECIAL CALLED MEETING IS TO DISCUSS SEEKING THE
CONVEYANCE OF THE HARALSON COUNTY BOOT CAMP PROPERTY

Mayor Sewell called the special meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.

Although there are two Council Members absent, Mayor Sewell stated that we do have a quorum as well as the full support of both, Council Member Wilson and Council Member Shepherd.

Mayor Sewell stated that she has been in contact with the Georgia State Properties Commission in regards to obtaining the Haralson Boot Camp Property for the purpose of Haralson County needing a new jail facility.

The response from the State Properties Commission is that they will sell the property, for ten dollars, to any government entity who may need the facility upon meeting the usage guidelines.

Mayor Sewell notified the county and told them that should they decide against this property for a jail facility for the county, Bremen would like to obtain it for the purposes of having a municipal jail as well as having police and fire on the bypass.

Haralson County Commissioners have stated that they do not wish to move the Haralson County Jail to the Boot Camp location.

Since they are not going to use the property as a jail facility and they have no planned use for the facility, Mayor Sewell stated that she has prepared a resolution and wrote a letter to the Georgia State Properties Commission requesting the Boot Camp Property be obtained by the City of Bremen for purposes of police and fire protection along the bypass as well as a municipal jail. She read both the resolution and the letter to Council and asked for approval.

A motion was made by Council Member Parrish to approve the Resolution as presented by Mayor Sewell. Council Member Crawford seconded the motion made by Parrish. Mayor Sewell voted in favor of the motion. The motion carried.

Mayor Sewell stated that Chief Pesnell will take our request directly to the State Properties Commission to hand deliver these documents.

Council Member Crawford made a motion seconded by Council Member Parrish to adjourn the special called council meeting.
